
 Once you log-in, you can also use the top bar to update your details, reset your password or contact help support








Shows current placements and assessments to be completed



The Visual Analogue Scale: VAS




- The letters N, I and E have been added to represent Novice, Intermediate and Entry-level

Student and Educator Mid Placement Ratings




 Student and Educator Mid-Placement ratings are now clearly labelled and shown in grey on End placement assessments



Placement Overview- Mid





 You will also be advised if you have marked your student near, but NOT <u>AT</u> Entry-level






