Coronavirus Vaccination Information Sign Descriptions



HEALTHY


ALL

Hold dominant hand bent at 3rd knuckles to side of chest, fingers touching. Move hand forward while closing it into fist with thumb extended.



SAFE


Move blade of slightly cupped dominant hand, across open palm of non-dominant hand towards body.



Hold dominant hand open and flat, palm facing down, move hand in large circle in front of body.



VACCINE/INJECTION Mime giving injection to oneself (natural gesture).



PERSON (people) Extend dominant index finger. Brush formation down tip of nose, twice.



CORONAVIRUS


Hold non-dominant hand in a fist with palm facing down. Hold dominant hand in a fist behind non-dominant hand, then swivel fist up while opening to fingers spread.



GO

Swing slightly cupped dominant hand forward in relevant direction. Finish with straight fingers. *With directionality.

DOCTOR Extend dominant




Coronavirus Vaccination Information Sign Descriptions

NURSE



With thumbs meeting in the middle of forehead, index fingers extended, move hands apart with index fingers closing onto thumb on either side of head.



SUPPORT

Hold dominant hand in a fist on non-dominant palm. Move formation up and slightly forward.



MASK Natural Gesture, mime applying facemask.



SIT

Place open dominant hand on back of non-dominant hand and move formation down slightly. *With directionality.



WAIT Bounce open dominant hand, palm down, in front of dominant side, twice. *May use both hands (natural gesture).




STILL (stay)

Bounce open dominant hand, palm down, in front of dominant side. *May use both hands (natural gesture).




HURT/SORE (pain) Shake open dominant hand, fingers spread, twice in front of body or over location of pain (with placement).



SHORT/A BIT (little) Place hands open with palms facing and move them together (or use natural gesture appropriate to the context).




TIME Extend dominant thumb and index finger. Place dominant thumb in palm of nondominant hand and swivel formation to palm down.



HOME


Move slightly cupped dominant hand, palm away from body, in an arc away from body and down.




SICK Extend dominant little finger. Slide little finger edge down same side of upper chest. *May use two hands.



DAY Sweep open dominant hand, palm down or palm towards body, in an arc from waist height to shoulder height.



TELL (talk) Move tip of extended dominant index finger forward away from mouth.



COUPLE (two)

Extend dominant index and middle fingers, fingers pointing up, hold fingers slightly apart, palm toward body (natural gesture).



GOOD Extend dominant thumb, close rest of fingers into fist, thumb pointing up, move forward with stress (natural gesture).
